WHAT IS WEATHERIZATION?

The Weatherization Assistance Program is the nation's largest residential energy efficiency program. Very simply, weatherization improves heating efficiency and fuel savings by ensuring your home holds heat and air-conditioning in, while keeping the hot and cold air out. At no charge to the client, income eligible households receive a comprehensive home assessment which includes repair or replacement of heating systems, insulation and caulking.

WHY WEATHERIZE?

Weatherization increases the comfort of your home, saves money, reduces dependence on foreign oil, preserves housing stock and provides safe, affordable housing. Without weatherization homes lose heat or air conditioning, making units work harder at maintaining a constant temperature inside the house. This not only wastes energy, but increases both utility and maintenance costs.

WHAT'S INCLUDED?

Weatherization repairs may include:

- ⇒ Weather-stripping, and caulking around doors and windows
- ⇒ Cleaning, testing, repairing or replacing of heating systems
- ⇒ Adding insulation to walls, ceilings and foundations for infiltration reduction

IHS MISSION

Interfaith Housing Services shall develop, promote and implement programs which assist persons of low to moderate incomes to meet their housing needs.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Eligibility is based on household income relative to federal low-income guidelines. If a household contains a member who receives Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) or Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP) benefits, the household is automatically considered eligible for weatherization services. Other income guidelines are:

ARE RENTERS ELIGIBLE?

If eligibility guidelines are met, renters may apply for weatherization services, as well.
